Puppy Class: Set your puppy up for success! In addition to teaching the pups to safely navigate “puppy” agility obstacles (which helps build confidence and body awareness), this class will help your puppy gain leash manners, to come when called, housebreaking, puppy behaviors such as chewing, digging, stealing, jumping up, running away & more.

For puppies under 5 months of age when the class begins. Smaller dogs with shyness / confidence issues can also benefit from this class. Pups should have at least their 2nd round of puppy shots before attending class. First week is an orientation without the dogs.

Beginning Obedience: Teach your dog

good leash manners, sit & down stays, to come when called, how to greet others properly, learn some fun tricks, games, & more. Need assistance with behavior issues such as stealing things, running out of doors, etc? We will address these issues as well. For dogs over the age of 5 months of age. First week is an orientation without the dogs.

***Highly reactive dogs may need a private lesson before joining group classes.** Please contact us if you have any questions.

Advanced Obedience: Hone your dog’s manners or prepare your dog for CGC (Canine Good Citizen), Therapy Dog, Rally, Agility, and other performance sports. For dogs that have completed Beginning Obedience or with instructor’s permission. Bring dogs to first class.

Stellar Canine Citizen: Fine-tune & enhance your dog’s skills and behaviors in preparation for the Canine Good Citizen test, Therapy Dog work, service & assistance, and more. For dogs that have completed Advanced Obedience or with instructor’s permission. Bring dogs to first class.

Puppy Agility: For puppies under 9 months. No previous classes needed. All equipment will be at low, safe settings. We will also work on socialization & manners.

Beginning Agility: For all dogs that have had their second set of shots and over 12 weeks of age. All equipment will be introduced at a low safe height. We will also work on socialization, manners, off leash skills and more.

Advanced Agility: For dogs that have completed Beginning Agility or with instructor's permission.

Novice Agility: For dogs that are just starting to compete in agility or with instructor's permission.

Open & Elite Agility: For dogs that are currently competing in higher levels of agility or with instructor's permission.

Drop in: for all dogs currently enrolled in classes.

Private Lessons

From helping your new puppy start off on the right paw to reactive and fear issues, we are here to help you both be successful! All Private Lessons include free email & phone follow-ups for 2 months.
